

Project Officer (Ref: 2301201) Research and Development Office (Knowledge Transfer Sub-Office)

The appointee will participate in various research projects related to system integration including wireless hardware and software development and development of a platform-independent software framework. Major duties include (i) to plan, supervise, coordinate, and execute the various professional activities and projects; (ii) to prepare reports and proposals; (iii) to provide administrative support to the research team; (iv) to work with relevant departments and teams for the research projects which include system integration, IoT applications and microwave engineering; (v) to support enhancement of the work of the research team and (vi) to perform any other duties as assigned by supervisor. There will be opportunities for manuscript writing and publication in international journals.

Applicants should have a bachelor's degree in Electronic Engineering /Computer Engineering/Mechanical Engineering or related disciplines, plus normally 2 years or more of relevant post-qualification experience in front-end and back-end system development. Possession of experience in whole system/hardware integration and knowledge in microwave engineering would be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
