The appointee will be responsible for teaching higher diploma, undergraduate and postgraduate courses on digital competency, such as artificial intelligence literacy and digital literacy. He/she will also be expected to contribute to the Centre's projects and initiatives, as well as to conduct research, supervise student projects, and undertake administrative duties as assigned. The ideal appointee will be proficient in teaching in both Chinese and English. The appointee is expected to commence the appointment in July 2024.

For the post of Lecturer I, applicants should have a Master's Degree in Computer Science, Information Technology, Artificial Intelligence, Data Science or a related discipline, plus a minimum of 4 years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience. Applicants should possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other equivalent qualification. A Doctoral Degree in relevant discipline is preferable. Proven evidence of quality teaching and/or a successful record of relevant professional experience is required. Applicants with less relevant post-qualification teaching experience may be considered for the post of Lecturer II.
