The Department of Linguistics and Modern Language Studies seeks a proactive, research-oriented, and highly motivated and organised individual to contribute to the above project. The successful candidate will work closely with the project leader to ensure timely completion of project tasks in accordance with the schedule. Responsibilities include developing project-related teaching and learning materials, conducting literature review, developing and piloting research tools, collecting data, conducting quantitative and qualitative data analysis, drafting research articles and reports, and other ad hoc duties as assigned by the project leader. The appointment will be 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree plus one year's post Master's degree full-time working experience, preferably with a Doctoral degree in English language education, Educational technology or related areas, with research experience in corpus technology and/or AI technology, and familiar with statistical tools and tools for conducting social network analysis. Applicants should preferably have a high proficiency in both English and Chinese, attentive to fine details, highly self-motivated, and able to work within tight timelines. Strong academic writing skills would be an advantage.
