The University is now seeking applications for the post of Senior Lecturer I and Senior Lecturer II for its new strategic areas in Environment, Social and Governance (ESG), Sustainability, and STEM. The appointees will be responsible for teaching courses at the new programme in these areas. Additionally, they are expected to contribute to curriculum and programme development, programme and course management, development/implementation of new projects and partake in departmental activities/meetings and various boards and committees, and provide good service contributions to the University and the community.

The appointees should have relevant teaching and professional/practical experience in the fields of ESG, Sustainability, STEM, or related fields.

Applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 8 years' relevant postqualification teaching / professional experience in relevant areas; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience in the relevant subject discipline.

Priority will be given to those with experience in teaching professional courses at the tertiary level, and/or delivery of consultancy services.

It would be advantageous to applicants to have the ability to teach through more than one medium of instruction (English/ Cantonese/ Putonghua).
