Project Title: Well-being and quality of life of individuals with SEN and their caregivers: Capacity building, research and scholarship and generating social impacts

[Appointment Period: 18 months]

The appointees will provide research support to projects on the well-being and quality of life of individuals with SEN and their caregivers. They will assist in the application for potential overseas or local grants, writing research/project proposals; conducting research activities including data collection, analysis, publication of findings in high-quality peer-reviewed journals, books/chapters, and reports; undertaking research project/programme in collaboration with the supervisor(s) and their research teams and research postgraduate students; and presenting findings in conferences, seminars, meetings, and knowledge transfer occasions; and performing any other research-related duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator and or his/her delegate(s). The initial appointment will be for a period of 18 months.

Applicants should have a PhD in Psychology or a related discipline with specialization in SEN or a relevant area. Experience in working with individuals with SEN or their caregivers and publication records in the same area are advantages. They should have sound experience with qualitative and/or quantitative methodologies, and knowledge in statistical analysis. Applicants should have an excellent command of both written English and Chinese, proficiency in spoken Cantonese. They should also possess self-motivation, good organizational skills, strong interpersonal and communication abilities, the ability to work independently and collaboratively as an effective team member, and the capacity to handle work under pressure.
