## Project Title: Digitalizing and gamifying corpus linguistics for virtual teaching and learning [Appointment Period: 12 months]

The appointee will participate in projects related to digitizing and gamifying corpus linguistics for teaching and learning. He/She will be involved in a wide range of research activities, such as reviewing literature, collecting and analyzing data, preparing research reports, and undertaking project-related administrative work. This may include contacting university students, school teachers, and programmers, arranging meetings, and contributing to the design of a mobile app. He/she will also need to perform other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree or above in Linguistics/Language Studies, Language Sciences, Language Education or a related discipline, with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience, or an approved qualification or equivalent standard. Applicants should have a good command of spoken and written English and Chinese, and being familiar with corpus linguistics and discourse analysis is desirable. Preference will be given to those with extensive linguistic research experience. Passion for educational research and sustainable development is desirable.
