The appointee will assist the project investigator in coordinating research projects on the Dynamic Interplay between microplastics and harmful species in Coastal Waters. The primary duties include reviewing the literature, conducting both lab and fieldwork, and performing extensive data analysis and scientific writing for publication. They will also be responsible for drafting reports and proposals for submission and performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for around 3 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree plus one year's post Master's degree full-time working experience or a PhD degree or above. Relevant research experience in (1) coastal pollution and (2) data science is preferred. Preference will also be given to applicants with good knowledge of coastal waters-related research, rich experience in fieldwork, and the ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision. They should also be a good team player, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Immediate availability is preferred.
