Project Title: Investigating the Factors Associated with Teachers' Feedback Literacy: Instrument Development and Validation

[Appointment Period: 12 months]

The appointee will participate in several research projects (last for three years), aiming to inform the in- and pre-service teachers' feedback literacy to benefit various education stakeholders. She/he will learn and be involved in a wide range of research knowledge and skills: literature review, communicate with local teachers and schools, and experts in feedback literacy to collect qualitative and quantitative data, and prepare research reports under supervision. She/he will also learn and use advanced research methods to analyze qualitative and quantitative data, and perform other duties as assigned. The applicator must have experience on academic writing, best on journals. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants for Senior Research Assistant should have a master's degree or prefer a doctoral degree in Psychology/Education/Statistics or a related disciplines plus one year post Master's degree full-time working experience.

Applicants for Research Assistant I should have a Bachelor's degree in Psychology /Education or a related disciplines.

They should have extensive academic writing experience; A good command of spoken and written English, and be able to communicate in Cantonese and preferably Mandarin; being Responsible, fast learning, self-motivated, and meticulous; Preferably extensive psychological or educational research experience (e.g. published journal articles, final year research project / thesis, knowledge of statistical analysis using Mplus, R, or Winsteps – please submit these files when apply); and Passion for educational research and sustainable development is desirable.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
