

Assistant School Partnership and Field Experience Manager (Ref: 2401280) School Partnership and Field Experience Office

The appointee will provide administrative support to the University's Field Experience activities and school & community partnership schemes. He/she will be responsible for planning and organising student placements; supporting the management of courses; coordinating school and community partnership and student activities in Hong Kong and beyond, including the Greater Bay Area; providing secretariat services to committees and working groups; preparing reports and proposals; liaising with schools, community partners and internal departments; supervising a team of supporting staff; supporting activities/conferences/projects that help establish partnerships and promote partners' engagement; and performing any other duties as assigned by supervisors. The appointment will be for a period of around 24 months.

Applicants should have a recognized degree, with several years of post-qualification working experience in tertiary institutions, public organizations or private sectors. They should have high proficiency in English and Chinese (Cantonese and Putonghua) as well as digital competency; excellent interpersonal and communication skills; and good analysis and problem-solving skills. They should be attentive to details and able to work under pressure.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits. The appointee will hold a substantive rank of Executive Officer II in the University.
