The appointee will provide implementation support for the project on the development of a new Capstone Project (CP) pathway focusing on emerging technologies (e.g., AI) in teaching/work contexts. Duties include liaising with the three faculties to ensure smooth project implementation, exploring emerging technologies and building prototypes for demonstration, developing evaluation instruments, organizing training workshops and prototype sharing sessions, as well as creating a collection of good practices and success stories.

The appointee will also produce videos/webpages for the project deliverables, evaluate the project implementation, draft project reports and journal papers, and perform other duties assigned by the Centre Director and Associate Directors. The appointment will be for a period of around 20 months.

For the position of Educational Development Officer, applicants should have a recognized Bachelor's degree, preferably in Education, Psychology, Social Sciences, Artificial Intelligence, Computer Science, STEM, or related disciplines, with at least 2 years of post-qualification full-time working experience. They should have good written and verbal communication skills in both English and Chinese (including spoken Cantonese), a high capability of developing educational materials, good computer literacy, strong analytical and problem-solving skills, and attention to detail. They should be self-motivated to work independently while also possessing good interpersonal skills to work effectively as a team member. Knowledge of AI, STEAM, metaverse, computer programming, and the use of statistical packages such as SPSS and R will be advantageous.
