The Department of International Education is seeking qualified and highly dedicated researchers to provide research support to an Early Career Scheme project entitled “National Education in Hong Kong in the new era”. This project uses thematic analysis to examine government documents, major news media, and government-endorsed school textbooks from 2020 to 2026, identifying the official approach to promoting national education and its limitations, and providing suggestions to improve national education. The appointee will assist in duties such as literature review, data collection and analysis, report and journal drafting, and any other duties as assigned. The appointment period will be 24 months.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably have a Bachelor’s Degree in education or familiar with civic/national education and thematic analysis. Applicants should be adept at multi-tasking, working under tight schedules, and working independently and as a team. They should also demonstrate a good command of English, Cantonese and/or Mandarin and be able to read traditional Chinese characters.
