The appointee will be responsible for conducting educational research related to STEAM education. He/she will assist the Principal Investigator in

- Providing logistics in supporting students' coding using Micro:bit and scratch to develop their solution in relation to global warming;
- Assisting in collecting quantitative and qualitative data, including video recording and questionnaire;
- Liaising with schoolteachers and students;
- Supervising student helpers;
- Reviewing literature and drafting research papers; and
- as well as any duties related to the project.

Applicants should have (i) a Bachelor's degree of above, preferably in the areas of Science Education, Technology Education or a related field of education; (ii) experience in teaching in K-12 education; (iii) excellent interpersonal and communication skills; (iv) proficiency in written English and Chinese and spoken English and Cantonese.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
