The appointee will work on various research projects related to data analytics. He/She will be responsible for updating analytics models, algorithms, platforms and systems, performing data analysis and collaborating with other departments on the deployment, integration and evaluation of analytics models and solutions; preparing research materials and assisting in the coordination and administrative work of research projects; and performing any other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of around 36 months.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree in Data Science, Statistics, or related disciplines, plus one-year post Master's Degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral Degree. They should have good programming and communication skills and be highly proficiency in both spoken and written English and Chinese. They should be self-motivated, responsible, and able to work independently. Previous full-time working experience in programming and/or research projects will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
