**Project Title: Comparison of internal state and executive functions of children with cognitive disengagement syndrome and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder**

**[Appointment Period: 12 months]**

The appointee will work for a project investigating the neurophysiological and neuropsychological functions of children with attention disorders. He/She will assist the Principal Investigator to collect neuropsychological and neurophysiological data from children, conduct literature review and prepare manuscripts/progress reports. He/She will be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. The appointment will be for a period of around 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to funding availability and satisfactory performance.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Priority will be given to graduates of bachelor or master degree. Applicants should be proficient in computer literacy (Including MS Word, Excel, Chinese Word processing and database creation/management). They should have good command of English and Chinese speaking and writing skills; Experienced in handling children with special education needs (e.g. Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder) and able to work independently with good planning, organizational, and interpersonal/communication skills.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
