EdUHK President **Professor Stephen Cheung Yan-leung** paid tribute to the Honorary Fellowship recipients for their dedication to, and excellence in, their respective fields of endeavor. “They have also won recognition for their selfless contribution to society and have become role models for the next generation, embodying the positive qualities that have been instrumental to their success and that we seek to instil in our students,” said Professor Cheung.
