Introduction

The Global Research Institute for Finnish Education (GRIFE) at the Education University of Hong Kong is delighted to announce its 2nd Annual Conference, focused on Education Innovation and Talent Development for a Sustainable Future. As societies face rapid technological advancements and urgent global challenges, education systems are at a pivotal point. There is an increasing need for innovation in education, including nurturing individuals to be adaptable, forward-thinking, and oriented towards sustainability (Cai & Wolff, 2023). The conference will bring together scholars, practitioners, and policymakers to share research findings, exchange ideas, and discuss the following sub-themes:

- Fostering Educational Innovation: As educational institutions strive to equip students for an uncertain future, the need for innovation has become increasingly critical. This sub-theme will highlight groundbreaking practices in pedagogy, curriculum design, and learning environments that support creativity and sustainability.
- **Developing Global Talent:** The cultivation of talent is essential for sustainable growth. Sessions will focus on strategies and policies that nurture skilled, adaptable, and ethically aware individuals who are capable of leading change across various sectors and communities.
- Leveraging Technology for Sustainable Education: As technology continues to transform education, this sub-theme will examine the role of digital tools and platforms in expanding access, fostering collaboration, and supporting sustainable educational practices across borders. Ethical considerations related to the use of advanced digital technologies will also be explored.
- **Building Supportive Policy Frameworks:** Education for sustainable development is supported by robust policy frameworks. Through a comparison of different policy approaches, participants will gain insights into how governments and educational institutions can collaborate to foster ecosystems that encourage innovation.

With contributions from international experts, educators, graduate students and policymakers, the conference aspires to create a rich environment for sharing research, discussing practical solutions, and fostering collaborations that can propel education towards a sustainable future.
